In the K Desktop Environment, the built-in program KSnapshot is the default screen grabbing utility.

GNOME users can take a screenshot either by selecting "Take Screenshot..." from the "Actions" menu (in GNOME 2.10 or greater), by using two keyboard shortcuts:
Screen, or
Currently active window.
